Do I need to Request Approval for Unit Alteration/Modification

Yes (please submit at least 10 business days before project start):

- Changing floor plan
- Installing new flooring
- o Installing Screen Doors
- Electrical work if moving or adding switches, outlets, etc.
- Plumbing work if connecting or disconnecting water supply or waste lines, including installing drinking water system, replacing hot water heater, sink, toilet, etc.
- Changing front door lock or lockset

No approval needed:

- Replacing HVAC unit ensure contractor protects balcony surfaces on the 9th and your floor from drips, nicks, and scratches when moving equipment to/from the elevator AND cleans roof.
- Interior painting
- Changing interior light fixtures or ceiling fans
- Installing blinds, drapery hardware, etc.
- Hanging shelves, artwork, etc.
